You are a visual artist and dogs are more to you than just motifs for commissioned works. How do dogs shape our lives - is it about love, companionship, protection, status or perhaps ...? We are looking for art that not only tells stories, inspires thought or laughter, but is also of a high artistic standard in terms of craftsmanship. The group exhibition also allows works of Artificial Intelligence, if this is clearly labelled and the development and the person behind it is documented.

Vita and artworks

ART-isotope is looking for around twelve artists who have been active in the art market for many years - preferably from the wider Wertheim region, but also from German-speaking countries or neighbouring Eastern European countries.

A maximum of two works (or several small formats) per artist from the fields of painting, sculpture, printmaking or photography are desired. As a rule, works of art should be able to be sent by parcel service or transported by you personally.

Exhibition rooms

The atmospheric New Archive of Wertheim Castle offers approx. 120 square metres of exhibition space (large hall, two round tower rooms plus adjoining room). For reasons of monument protection, there are slight restrictions in terms of hanging, but platforms are available for sculptures. In addition, a digitalisation of the rooms is in preparation, which will provide additional exhibition possibilities.

Visitors

The exhibition follows on from the long-standing exhibition series 'Kunstsommer Burg Wertheim', for which extensive documentation is available on our website (projects > downloads). The audience to date has been broadly diversified: from art lovers and tourists visiting the picturesque Wertheim Castle to school classes and professionals from the fields of art management/history, curation, etc.

Jury

The artworks/participants will be selected by Axel Schöber (gallery owner), Christian Schlager, Marianne Tazlari (former museum director) and N. N.

Application and submission deadline

Please submit a brief description of the works including title, technique, dimensions, selling price and a short text by e-mail. Photos (RGB, JPG/PNG/PDF) of the works and a short CV are also required*.

Commission: depending on the work - between 33 % (e.g. bronze) and 50 % (painting) **Documents:** *by 5 May 2024

Submission of works: by 28 June 2024 - you will receive details upon admission
